- Credit to the MGA's account by GCAI suggests 213 members while Bradecamp's numbers suggest 216. Budget calls for 220 members so revenue is below budget by \$875. The difference in membership numbers will be investigated.
- Lunch Expenses and other expenses had a YTD variance to budget of (\$1,309)
- Total variance to budget through March was (\$2,184)
- Research will be conducted to see who were the recent "Super Seniors" winners in the Club Championship for potential plaques to honor these players.
