Committee Reports:

Treasury – Present by Charlie Morris

- Credit to the MGA's account by GCAI suggests 215 members. With 5 additional credits due, this would bring the number of MGA members to 220, right on budget.
- April MGA event lunch was comped. Expect 2 more.
- Current cash position about \$36,000. Will decline over the year since membership dues are collected at the beginning of the year.
- \$20,000 has been the recent low for net assets. Need to build that figure up.

Competition Committee – Jim Blackburn

- Results of Tarlow Cup and Member/Member will be updated next week.

Communication Committee – Owen Murphy

- The current website Concert Golf interface person, Rachael, is leaving the company. Owen has not been introduced to her replacement at this point and expects there to be a learning curve.

Handicap Committee – Jim Casey

- Jim does spot check to see if players are posting scores.
- Starter sheets would be a good source of who is playing.

Interclub -

- With just a few holes to go, The Nest, TPC Tampa Bay, ContinentalCC, Carrollwood CC and Marsh Landing were all within 5 points of each other. Carrollwood was the first to finish, and became the leader in the clubhouse at 362 total points, thanks to a great closing round of 192 points. With one hole to play, Marsh Landing had a chance to defend their title if they just came through with seven points, and TPC Tampa Bay still stood an outside chance of going wire-to-wire.
