

# GCAI MGA Player of the Year Criteria

Player of the Year (POY) is determined by points awarded largely on monthly MGA event dollar payout values. There are 2 exceptions: Tarlow Cup and the Concert Cup Qualifier.

1. 20 points are awarded by playing each month. The first ability is availability. After that, cash is king.
2. Tarlow Cup is credit book and each payout in credit book equates to points.
3. Concert Cup Qualifier has actual dollar values for points but the winning team has an all expense paid trip to the final event awarding no cash value. So, the money awarded to the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team is awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> place team in points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place team money goes to 2<sup>nd</sup> place team and so on and so forth as POY points.
4. If there is no cash pay out because of a tie in any MGA event, resolved by the approved tie breaker, there are no points applied.
5. Win Money Men - This is the MGA!
