

GCAI MGA Player of the Year and Most Improved Player Criteria

Player of the Year:

Player of the Year (POY) is determined by points awarded during the monthly MGA event. **Each dollar earned is equal to one POY point.** Approximately 25% of the field (top placing teams or individuals) will earn pro-shop credit book & day money.

- All events will cost \$25 Club Credit Book Entry fee & a \$20 cash pot buy-in collected the day of the event.

If there is no cash payout because of a tie in any MGA event, resolved by the approved USGA tie breaker, there are no points applied.

There are 3 exceptions: Participation points, Tarlow Cup and the Concert Cup Qualifier points.

1. 20 points are awarded for playing each monthly event.
2. Tarlow Cup is credit book and each payout in credit book equates to points.
3. Concert Cup Qualifier has actual dollar values for points, but the winning team has an all-expense paid trip to the final event awarding no cash value. So, the money awarded to the 2nd place team is awarded to the 1st place team in points, 3rd place team money goes to 2nd place team and so on and so forth as POY points.

Most Improved Player Award:

Most Improved calculations will be weighted by the greater percentage of Handicap Index (HCI) decrease over the year, not simply the number of strokes dropped.

Example – On Jan 1st, a 20 HCI golfer drops to 16 on Dec 31st is a 20% decrease; a 6 HCI golfer drops to a 2 is a 66% decrease. The 6 HC golfer is the Most Improved.
